WHEREAS:	Last year, people in Minnesota visited their local public library more than 12 million times, submitted nearly 2 million reference requests to trained library staff, and attended over 55,000 programs held at their local library branch; and
WHEREAS:	For decades, grateful community members have banded together into the nonprofit "Friends of the Library" to champion library services and the staff who maintain these vital community assets; and
WHEREAS:	"Friends" are a grassroots group dating back to the 1920s. Their presence continues strong to this day with a collective 19,700 members across Minnesota; and
WHEREAS:	Friends benefit 58 percent of public library systems in Minnesota, and, in some communities, Friends groups also exist to support the mission and activities of university libraries and K-12 school media centers; and
WHEREAS:	Friends are vocal and hardworking advocates for their library's continued public funding. Among core activities, Friends of the Library fill important fundraising functions, unlocking program and outreach opportunities; and
WHEREAS:	Friends are particularly visible as the coordinators of regular and beloved used book sales, providing funding for library programs and services in their community; and
WHEREAS:	Beyond fundraising, many Friends groups supplement their library's offerings by hosting programs including author talks, book clubs, and children's programs; and
WHEREAS:	Friends in many Minnesota communities can also be found volunteering their time in the library itself: reshelving books, staffing desk shifts, and even providing custodial services; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesota recognizes Friends of Libraries and celebrates their work championing and sustaining library services across Minnesota.
